“A Phase II Trial on the Effect of Low-Dose versus High-Dose Vitamin D Supplementation on Bone Mass in Adults with Neurofibromatosis Type 1 (NF1)”

What is this research study?

This is a randomized clinical trial of oral vitamin D therapy in adults with NF1 and vitamin D insufficiency. We are looking for about 320 adults with known NF1 to participate in this study. The purpose of this study is to treat adults with two different doses of vitamin D to determine which dose is most appropriate to maintain bone mineral density of the spine and hip.

Where do I go for study visits?

This study is being conducted at: University of Utah (Salt Lake City, Utah), University of British Columbia (Vancouver, British Columbia), and University of Cincinnati (Cincinnati, Ohio).

Will it cost me anything?

There is no cost to you for study visits. Travel help to sites is available, however may not cover the full cost of traveling to study sites.
