Dear Taxpayer:

This is in response to your request dated Sep. 21, 2017, regarding your tax-exempt status.

We issued you a determination letter in February 1990, recognizing you as tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(3).

IRC Section 6033(j) provides that, if you don't file a required annual information return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked on the filing due date of the third required return or notice.
