


Neurofibromatosis Type-2 (NF2) is a disorder characterized by the growth of noncancerous tumors throughout the nervous system, the most common being vestibular schwannomas or acoustic neuromas. Neurofibromatosis has a 50% chance of occuring spontaneously, and another 50% chance to be passed on genetically. Below are potential symptoms of NF2.
